Acting under the authority of La. R.S. 1:55 (E) (2), and considering the uncertainties of the extent of the impact of a severe weather system expected to cause storm-related conditions, as well as possible tornadoes in the late afternoon,

Robichaux, Clerk of Court**, do hereby declare than an emergency situation exists which renders it hazardous or otherwise unsafe for employees of the Terrebonne Parish Clerk of Court to continue in the performance of their official duties and to travel to and from the Courthouse and for the general public to conduct business with the Terrebonne Parish Clerk of Court.

Therefore, the office of the Terrebonne Parish Clerk of Court shall be closed Wednesday, December 14, only from 2:30 o'clock p.m., through 4:30 o'clock p.m.

That day of closure shall be considered a legal holiday as provided by La. R.S. 1:55 (E) (3).

If conditions require that the office of the Terrebonne Parish Clerk of Court remain closed beyond December 14, 2022, notice of the extension of said closure will be posted at www.terrebonneclerk.org and in the news media.
